About the Instructors

Valerie R. Newman has been an appellate attorney with SADO for over 20 years. She has argued hundreds of cases before the Michigan appellate courts and two cases before the United States Supreme Court. She successfully represented the defendant in Lafler v Cooper, a 2011 decision the New York Times heralded as the most important right to counsel case since Gideon v Wainwright. Ms. Newman is the recipient of numerous awards, including the SBM's Champion of Justice Award in 2013 for making significant contributions to the community, state, and nation. She is an adjunct professor of law at the University of Michigan Law School, and is an experienced trainer, having presented for the Criminal Defense Attorneys of Michigan (CDAM), the Michigan Appellate Bench Bar, and at the NLADA's National Appellate Defense and Persuasive Writing Skills Institute as an advanced U.S. Supreme Court skills track instructor.

Bradley R. Hall is an experienced appellate attorney and the current Administrator of MAACS. Prior to MAACS, Mr. Hall worked as an attorney at the Federal Defender Office in Detroit for eight years where he specialized in habeas corpus cases and appeals in the U.S. Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals. He is co-chair of the CDAM Amicus Curiae Committee, and in that capacity has filed briefs and presented oral argument in the Michigan Supreme Court on important issues of criminal law and procedure. Mr. Hall has published articles on criminal procedure and wrongful convictions in the Wisconsin Law Review, Drake Law Review and the Journal of Criminal Law and Criminology. Mr. Hall recently received the Cooley Law School's Distinguished Brief Award, is the past author of SADO's Defender Habeas book and is an experienced trainer having presented at numerous CDAM conferences.
