What are Case Rounds?

- Case Rounds is a group of 4-6 MAACS Roster Attorneys who want to talk about their cases. Attorneys can bring specific or general case or procedural issues to the group for discussion, brainstorming, and collaboration.
- Each session will start with a short discussion on a specific topic chosen by the host. Topics will range from: motions to extend, novel issues in plea cases, e-filing, late requests for counsel, 42 day cases, missing transcripts, client relationships, and more.

What kind of technical capabilities do I need to participate in Case Rounds?

There are 3 options:

1. **Join on a device with a camera, speakers, and a microphone** (i.e., a cell phone with a camera or a laptop with a webcam): All participants will be able to see and hear you and you will be able to see and hear all participants. [PREFERRED METHOD].
2. **Join on a device with speakers and a microphone** (i.e., a computer without a webcam): All participants will be able to hear you and you will be able to see and hear all participants.
3. **Join by phone:** All participants will be able to hear you and you will be able to hear all participants.

Who will be at Case Rounds?

- Case Rounds are open to MAACS Roster Attorneys only. The maximum number of participants is 6.
- Case Rounds will be hosted by SADO Assistant Defender and Training Director, Marilena David-Martin unless otherwise specified. The host will help facilitate the discussion.

What happens after I register?

- You will be notified whether your registration has been accepted and will get an email with the logon information.
- You may be asked to email Marilena directly (mdavid@sado.org) with the name of your client, the county of the case, and any known co-defendants to ensure there are no conflicts with anyone on the call.
