MOTION FOR REDUCTION OF JAIL SENTENCE

NOW COMES Defendant SEAN PETER ERHARD, by and through his attorney, the STATE APPELLATE DEFENDER OFFICE, by JACQUELINE C. OUVRY, and moves this Honorable Court to reduce his jail sentence and says in support thereof that:

- 1. Defendant Sean Peter Erhard pled guilty to delivery and manufacture of marijuana, illegal sale of medical marijuana, on May 25, 2011 in the Berrien County Circuit Court.
- 2. On June 27, 2011, the Honorable Angela M. Pasula sentenced Mr. Erhard to a term of one year incarceration in the county jail.
- 3. Mr. Erhard is currently scheduled for release from the jail on February 9, 2012. If the Court grants a ¼ reduction of his jail sentence for good behavior, Mr. Erhard could be eligible for release today.
 - 4. MCL 801.257 provides for a ¼ reduction of the jail sentence by the Court:

801.257. Reduction of term for good conduct

Sec.7. Except as provided in section 5 of the prisoner reimbursement to the county act and section 5a of chapter 171 of the Revised Statutes of 1846, being section 801.5a of the Michigan

- Compiled Laws, a prisoner may receive, if approved by the court, a reduction of 1/4 of his or her term if his or her conduct, diligence, and general attitude merit such reduction.
- 5. According to Lieutenant Kevin Allred of the Berrien County Jail, in a telephone conversation with counsel on December 1, 2011, information regarding an inmate's behavior is non-public and cannot be released even to appellate counsel. But, according to Joanne Roberts, Population Control at the Berrien County Jail in a telephone conversation with counsel on December 1, 2011, Mr. Erhard is participating in the Fresh Start program and earns programming time for that participation. Because Mr. Erhard is participating in available programming and because counsel has no information that Mr. Erhard exhibits anything other than good conduct, Mr. Erhard asserts that his conduct, diligence and general attitude would merit a reduction.
- 6. Mr. Erhard also requests this Court's consideration of a reduction in jail sentence because his wife is suffering from terminal breast cancer in the state of Colorado. In an attached letter, Mrs. Erhard's treating physician indicates that as of June 3, 2011 Mrs. Erhard had a 1 ½ to 3 year life expectancy and would benefit from as much support as is available to participate in treatment while providing care to her young daughter. *Letter*, attached as *Appendix A*. Upon his release, Mr. Erhard intends to return to Colorado to provide that support to both his wife and daughter.

WHEREFORE, Defendant respectfully requests that this Honorable Court reduce his current jail sentence by one quarter (1/4) with credit for time served under the authority of MCL 801.257.
